The scholarship award:

- Up to \$500 for one or two seniors one will receive up to \$500 or if two are awarded it would be \$250 each
- Payable directly to the student(s)
- Recipients(s) will be chosen by the Meridian Lions Club

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

- Current senior in Kuna or Meridian High Schools
- Applicant has demonstrated outstanding character and citizenship in their school and community
- A member in good standing and an active participant in their respective FFA Chapter
